HOG TROUGH

I was going to submit this one last month for the Easter Holiday, a Polish Babka, which means grandmother. However, I was on travel for work, to Poland! I didn't eat any babka but I had plenty of other Polish food. This recipe is from The Spruce Eats website.

Babka Wielkanocna: Easy Polish Easter Babka

- 1 Pkg. Active Dry Yeast (2 ¼ t)
- ¼ C Warm Water, not to exceed 110 °F
- 6 oz. Salted Butter, Cold
- ¾ C Sugar
- ½ t Salt
- 1 C Scalded Milk
- 1 t Vanilla Extract
- 3 Large Eggs
- 4 ¼ C All Purpose Flour
- 3 Eggs
- OPTIONAL:
- 2 T Lemon Zest
- ½ C Raisins, Light or Dark
- OPTIONAL ICING:
- 2/3 C Confectioner's Sugar
- 2 T Lemon Juice
- 1 T Boiling Water

Preheat oven to 350 °F.

In a small bowl, dissolve the yeast in warm water and set aside. If the mixture doesn't look bubbly after 15 minutes, it could mean your yeast is old. Start again with fresh yeast before proceeding to the next step.

Place butter, sugar, and salt in a large bowl or stand mixer, and pour the scalded milk over it. Using the paddle attachment, mix until the butter has melted and the milk has cooled to 110 F or below. Mix in the vanilla and eggs. Add yeast and mix until well combined.



HOG TROUGH (CONT.)

Add the flour, lemon zest (if using), and raisins and mix thoroughly. The dough will be of a thick cake batter consistency.

Lightly coat a 10-inch babka pan, kugelhopf pan, Turk's head pan (turban pan), Bundt pan, or tube pan with cooking spray.

Pour the batter into the prepared pan and cover lightly with greased plastic wrap. Let rise in a warm place until doubled in bulk or until dough reaches the top of the pan but no higher.

Bake about 40 to 45 minutes or until a toothpick inserted near the center comes out clean, or until an instant-read thermometer registers 190 °F.

Cool completely on a wire rack and dust with confectioners' sugar before serving or, immediately after cooling, with the optional icing.

OPTIONAL ICING

In a small bowl, whisk together 2/3 cup confectioners' sugar, lemon juice, and boiling water until smooth.

Drizzle over cooled cake.

TIP

Store cooled babka in an airtight cake saver at room temperature for up to one week.

Alternatively, the babka can be frozen by wrapping it in plastic wrap and placing it in a plastic freezer bag for up to six months.



Did You Know...?

- On the 1970s TV police series *CHiPS* actor **Erik Estrada** suffered a very serious motorcycle accident while filming an episode. Until he recovered, he literally shot his scenes from his hospital bed.
- Did you know **Steve McQueen's** famous 65 foot motorcycle jump in the movie *The Great Escape* was done by stand-in rider **Bud Ekins** and he did it in just one take?
- **Peter Fonda** wore the Captain America jacket and rode his chopper a week around Los Angeles before shooting began on the movie *Easy Rider*, to give them a broken-in look, and to get used to riding the radically designed bike. The American flag on the back of the jacket, and on the gas tank of the bike, caused him to be pulled over several times by the police.



- Actual motorcycle clubs were on the set of the 2003 movie *Biker Boyz* to aid with tricks, stunts, and racing. They include *Valiant Riders*, *Black Sabbath*, *G-Zer Tribe*, *Ruff Ryders*, *Soul Brothers*, *Total Package*, *Chosen Few*, *Rare Breed*, *Brothers of the Sun*, *Sisters of the Sun*, *Deuces*, and *Black Sabbath New Breed*.
- The sound made by the “motorcycle” that **Chris Pine** rides to the shuttle departing to Starfleet Academy in the 2009 film *Star Trek* is the same sound used on *The Jetsons* from 1962 for the “cars” they fly.
- The 2007 movie *Wild Hogs* features quick cameos from **Paul Teutul Sr.** and **Paul Teutul Jr.** of *American Chopper: The Series (2003)*. The two famous bike builders appear in the Wild Hogs’ favorite bar as the bar owner and a background patron. The olive-drab green bike the character named Jack (played by actor **Ray Liotta**) was riding is made by Orange County Choppers and features their logo on the motorcycle in the movie.

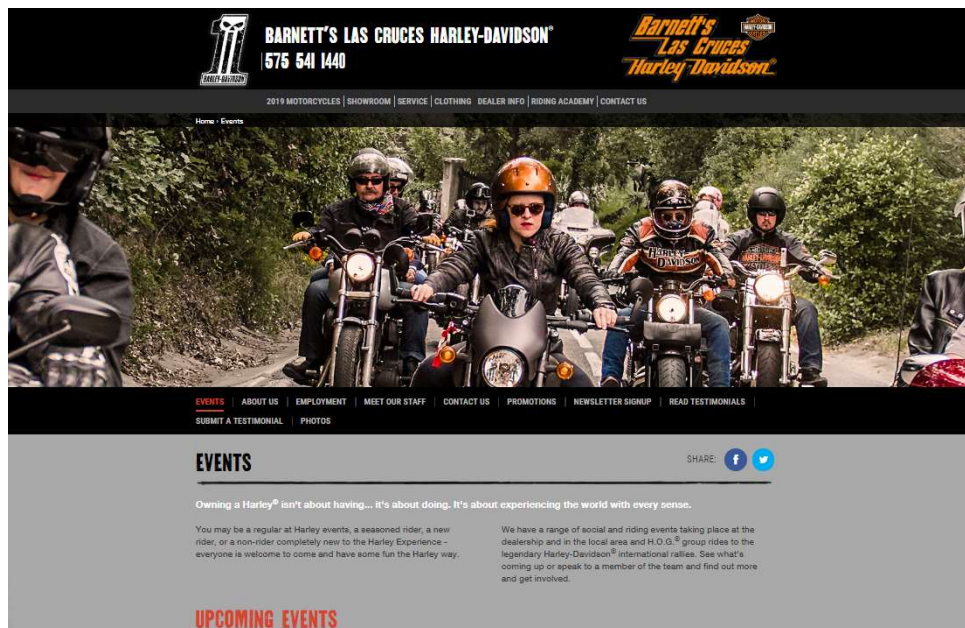
