## **HOG TROUGH**

The month of October is associated with Halloween and, of course, pumpkins. So why not combine a love of pumpkins with breakfast? This recipe is taken from A Taste Of Home, from 2014.

### **Fluffy Pumpkin Pancakes**

2/3 C All Purpose Flour  
1/4 C Sugar  
1 t Baking Soda  
1/4 t Ground Cinnamon  
2 Eggs  
2/3 C Vanilla Yogurt  
2 T Canola Oil  
Maple Syrup

2/3 C Whole Wheat Flour  
1 t Baking Powder  
1/2 t Pumpkin Pie Spice  
1/8 t Salt  
1 C Fat Free Milk  
2/3 C Canned Pumpkin  
1/4 t Vanilla Extract

In a large bowl, whisk the first eight ingredients.

In another bowl, whisk the eggs, milk, yogurt, pumpkin, oil and vanilla. Add pumpkin mixture to dry ingredients, stir until moistened.

Lightly coat a griddle with cooking spray, heat over medium heat. Use 1/2 cup of batter per pancake. Cook until bubbles on top begin to pop and bottoms are golden brown. Turn, cook until second side is golden brown.

Server with maple syrup.
